The Superior General, Fr. Valdir José De Castro, appointed him in his role for the three-year term 2018-2021 with a decree dated 4 September 2018.

Father Jacques, 50 years, was born in Bokoro, about 600 kilometres northeast of Kinshasa (Congo), on 2 February 1968. He entered the Society of St. Paul on 26 September 1989 in Kimwenza, and made his first profession on 11 September 1994, which he confirmed in perpetuity in Kinshasa on 5 September 1999. He completed his philosophy studies at the Saint Augustin University of Kinshasa (USAKIN) and theology at the Catholic University of Congo (UCC), with a Master in Pastoral Theology (1999).

Ordained a priest on 6 August 2000, he served first in the editorial sector and then, for a long time, in the diffusion, both in the bookshops (2001-2003) and as Director of the sector (2006-2011). He has a long experience also in the field of formation, having been a Master of Juniors (2005-2010) and Novices (2015-2017). He has also worked in the marketing and audio-visual sectors. He is the Delegate of the Pauline Cooperators from 2011 to today and held the position of Regional Vicar since 2012 until today.
