

18th PROVINCIAL CHAPTER of India-Great Britain-Ireland Province begins on November 9, 2021

The 18th India-Great Britain-Ireland Provincial Chapter began on 9 November 2021 at Alberione Hall, Bandra Mumbai. In view of the 11th General Chapter, the 18th Provincial Chapter started with a recollection talk given by Fr Dr Frazer Mascarenhas SJ, Parish Priest of St Peters Church who is also the Dean of Bandra deanery.
