Dear brothers,

In greeting you cordially, we are writing this last letter as Preparatory Commission on the eve of the XI General Chapter (29 May - 19 June), happy that the health conditions in Italy allow us to finally celebrate the long-awaited congregational event together and in safety. In fact, since April 30, in Italy the restrictions related to covid-19 have relaxed, even if it is advisable not to let one's guard down, given that there are still so many infected every day.

In our last meeting, held in Rome on 3 May, we verified that everything is now ready to welcome you. This letter is just to remind you of some practical matters before you leave.

We remind you that, to ensure everyone's safety, swab tests will be carried out in the Via Alessandro Severo Compound on 27 and 28 May. Those who will travel directly to Ariccia and will not have a certificate of negativity to the swab test carried out in the previous 2 days, is asked to notify Father Celso.

Among the things to pack, we remind everyone to bring their **Laptop** or **Tablet** to access the documents that will gradually be placed in a shared folder on the network; and the **Letters of Accreditation** to the General Chapter that have been given to you on the occasion of the Provincial Chapter or Regional Assembly. Finally, please inform us if you have **special needs regarding food and/or medicines**.

Looking forward to seeing you all again in Ariccia, we greet you with deep fraternal affection.
