REV. FR. PAOLO LANZONI

SECRETARY GENERAL Pro tempore



During their meeting on March 27, 2024, the Superior General, Fr. Domenico Soliman, with the consent of his Council appointed Fr. Paolo as the new Secretary General.

Fr. Paolo is 74 years old. He was born in Pieve di Cento (Bologna, Italy) on January II, 1950. He entered the Congregation in Modena on Sept. 6, 1961, made his First Profession on Aug. 20, 1968, followed by Perpetual Profession on Sept. 8, 1976. He was then ordained as Priest on June 18, 1978, in Catania, Italy.

In addition to being a formator of aspirants in the Catania Community, he worked in the music sector in Albano Laziale (Rome) from 1979 to 1986, where he composed several collections of liturgical songs.

His service as Provincial Secretary to the government of Italy Province from 1994 to 2002 is also noteworthy.

From 2005 to 2007 he was a member of the Vatican Community, and as a member of the Pauline Spirituality Center (2007-2013), he followed up on the Opera Omnia of Fr. James Alberione. He is also a constant animator of the Pauline Family, especially as a collaborator at the Holy Family Institute. Currently, he resides in the community of Florence.

We wish Fr. Paolo all the best as he begins his assignment as Secretary General and hope that he will have a fruitful service to the Congregation.
