THEIR RESPECTIVE SEATS

Dear brother Superiors and Delegates,

To all a greeting of grace and peace under the patronage of Mary Queen of the Apostles for the new year that has just begun.

As we learned last 12 January from Fr Valdir's letter, the General Government has decided to postpone the XI General Chapter, scheduled for 6 - 27 February 2022, due to the strong spread of the Covid-19 epidemic in Italy, which in recent weeks is reaching peaks of over 200 thousand infected per day. We remind you that the new date scheduled for the beginning of the Chapter is 29 May 2022, while the conclusion is scheduled for the following 19 June. Most likely, as happened last year, in this period of late spring in Italy the wave of Covid will have greatly diminished.

The Preparatory Commission, which met last 17 January, took note of the decision and will continue with its preparatory work for the Chapter in the ample four months that separate us from its inauguration. We will keep you updated on the situation. We invite you, however, from now on to reschedule your presence and that of the confrere Capitulars for that date, following the procedures adopted up to now (contacts with our Procurator General, with Consulates/Embassies, plane tickets, etc.). In any case, we inform you that the following vaccines have been authorized in Italy: *Comirnaty* by Pfizer-BioNtech, *Spikevax* (Moderna), *Vaxzevria* by AstraZeneca, *Janssen* (Johnson & Johnson) and *Nuvaxovid* (Novavax).

We also inform you that in the meantime, in accordance with the indications of the Superior General, on the occasion of the letter of convocation of the XI General Chapter of 6 August 2021, the circumscription Chapters and the Assemblies have been concluded. We are therefore able to send you the definitive list of all the Capitulars as an attachment.

We fraternally invite you to share this list with all the Paulines, also informing the members of the Pauline Family of your Circumscriptions, so that they can accompany this important event in prayerful expectation.
