At 12:30 we had an important appointment in the central Community of the Daughters of St Paul in Mexico, where Sr. Fátima Trujillo, Provincial Superior, and all the sisters fraternally welcomed us and invited us to share a fraternal lunch. Not lacking was the melodious music typical of the Mexican land, very devoted to our Lady of Guadalupe, “Queen of Mexico and Empress of the Americas”.

Finally, at 18:00, already in Tetela, the first informal encounter occurred for general orientation and various information. Today, Monday, at 7:00 am (local time) the work proper began with a paralyturgy presided by Fr Silvio Sassi.
