## BR. NATALE ANGELO PELLIZZARI 70 years, 59 of Pauline life, 51 of profession

His death is due to some renal complications, due to the presence of a tumor that for some time had already manifested itself. Besides the community, his sister Celestina has also lovingly been near to him.

Br. Natalino, thus he had been usually called, was born in Ramon di Loria (Treviso, Italy) on 25 December 1945, and was baptized five days later in the parish of San Pancrazio in Ramon. Still very young he leaves for Alba on 7 August 1956, answering a call that will make of his life a gift to the Lord and to his Gospel for almost sixty years as a Disciple of the Divine Master. In 1962 he starts his novitiate in Ostia (Rome) and makes his first religious profession on 20 August 1964. In Rome afterward he will make his perpetual profession in 1969.

From that moment on until today, Br. Natalino will always live in Alba, giving concreteness to his Pauline mission as a program analyst at the data eleaboration center of the Saint Paul Periodicals, an apostolate that sees him continuously committed in updating to answer the new challenges. Here he will put to fruition all his gifts, his analytical ability, but also his human and spiritual sensitivity, cultivated along the course of his life. Being of good spirit, often reserved, Br. Natalino has always loved music (he played the organ), a skill that allowed him to express what dwelt deep in himself as he helped the liturgical assembly to pray. He has been provincial councilor (1998-2002), bursar of the community of Alba Periodicals and of the Alba Motherhouse for some years, a service that he has always carried out with attention and care.

His life has also known physical suffering due to a problem in a leg, but with strength of mind for more than forty years he was able to live with this limitation, a daily school of silent offering. And yet Br. Natalino remains as a man with hope, amiable and serene in countenance, capable of giving out even a simple smile, always ready to overspend himself for the apostolate, aware that the Gospel, Jesus the Son of God, one lives Him and gives Him.

He will remain in the heart of one who has known him, because he is capable of showing the depth of the life of the one called to be a Disciple of the Divine Master.

We entrust him to the God of mercy, certain that the good done by him remains for all of us as a precious legacy. May he be received in Heaven by the Blesseds James Alberione and Timothy Giaccardo, together with Ven. Br. Andrea Borello and so many Paulines who have lived at the school of Jesus Master Way, Truth and Life.
