The Superior General, Father Valdir José De Castro, confirmed him in this office for another year with a decree of 5 December 2018.

Born in Pullurampara (Kerala, India) on 17 May 1970, Father Devasia joined the Society of St. Paul in 1986. He made his first profession in Bangalore on 30 June 1991 and the perpetual profession in Pune eight years later. A priest since 10 January 2000, he specialized in philosophy, carrying out assignments in formation until 2006 (Master of Juniors). In that year, he was called to Rome to be a member of the Centre of Pauline Spirituality, which he held until June 2014. In Rome, at the Institute of Spirituality of the Pontifical Gregorian University, he received his doctorate with a dissertation on the theme: *Paul, the Faithful Interpreter of "Jesus Master Way, Truth and Life" according to James Alberione. The Pauline Roots of the Spirituality of the Pauline Family.*

Returning to India, he was still the Master of the Juniors before being elected in October 2014 as Provincial Vicar and then appointed Director General of the Apostolate. In November 2017, the Superior General transferred him to the Portugal-Angola Region as his Delegate for a year.
